

Eyeliner What to Expect

Day 1

Swollen pink lids as if you have been crying or have bad allergies. The color will appear very dark.

Day 2

Swollen when you wake up, usually reduces by noon.

Day 3 - 4

Swelling decreases but is replaced with a "tight" feeling where liner is. This is the upper layer of pigment/scab to pull away. Do not pick.

Day 5 - 10

Sloughing and flaking will occur. It is normal to feel itchy. The pigment underneath the flaking may look very light. This is because of the new healed skin being cloudy.

Day 10+

The healed skin matures and becomes more clear, showing the true color underneath. This can take 2-3 weeks in some cases.

FYI

• Failure to follow just one step of the aftercare instructions can result in a total loss of pigment, risk infection, and/or discoloration of the pigment!
